To Whom it May Concern,

As a result of Governor Greg Abbott's proclamation declaring a state of disaster for all counties in Texas due to COVID-19, and in cooperation with state and local governments to reduce the community spread of COVID-19 all Driver License Offices are closed

In accordance with section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code, the Office of the Governor approved the Department's request to suspend provisions of the Texas Transportation Code to the extent necessary to delay the expiration date of Driver Licenses (DL), Commercial Driver Licenses (CDL), Personal Identification Cards (ID), and Election Certificates (EIC).

If a customer's Texas DL, ID, CLP, CDL card or EIC expires on or after March 13, 2020, or the license expired before March 13, 2020 and they have an extension letter from DPS, they will be granted a waiver for the expiration date for 60 days after the Department provides further public notice that normal operations have resumed.
