Effective March 16, 2020

Pursuant to instructions from OCA and under the authority of County Judge Stovall and Commissioners Court, all Justice of the Peace offices will be closed to the public from Monday, March 16 through Monday, March 23, 2020, with possible week to week renewal by Hunt County Commissioners Court.

Justice of the Peace offices will continue to conduct business by telephone and by mail.

The Justice Courts are reducing hearings to only Essential matters, which include, but may not be limited to:

- Writs of Re-Entry
- Writs of Retrieval
- Writ of Restoration

All other matters may be heard on a case by case basis.

Petitions for Evictions and Small Claims will be accepted through the mail, however, there will be no service on these cases during this period.

All Eviction, Small Claims and Debt Claim and Occupational License hearings will be reset to a later date.

All Pre-Trial hearings will be reset to a later date.

All Bench Trials and Jury Trials will be reset to a later date.
