ORDER TERMINATING COMMUNITY SUPERVISION EARLY

On this day came on to be considered the Defendant's Motion for Early Termination of Community Supervision, and the Court, having considered said Motion, the Court finds that:

1. **Eligibility Met:** The Defendant has satisfactorily completed more than one-third of the original probationary period, or two (2) years of community supervision, whichever is less.
2. **Compliance Verified:** The Defendant has paid all court costs, fines, fees, and restitution in full, and has successfully completed all court-ordered programs, counseling, and community service hours.
3. **Best Interests Served:** The best interests of society and the Defendant will be served by terminating the Defendant's period of community supervision.

It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** by the Court that the Defendant's community supervision be, and the same is hereby, **TERMINATED**.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Court that the Defendant is:

(STRAIGHT PROBATION)

- A. ☐ Discharged from community supervision.
- B. ☐ Discharged from community supervision. The Court **FURTHER ORDERS** that the Defendant's plea be withdrawn and the verdict be set aside. The Court **FURTHER ORDERS** that the accusation, complaint, information, or indictment be dismissed, and that the Defendant be released from all penalties and disabilities resulting from the conviction or plea in the case, except that (1) proof of the Defendant's conviction or plea shall be made known to the judge if the Defendant is convicted of any subsequent offense, and (2) if the Defendant is an applicant for or the holder of a license issued by the Department of Family and Protective Services (hereinafter "Department"), the Department may consider the fact that the Defendant previously received probation in issuing, renewing, denying, or revoking a license under Chapter 42, Human Resources Code.

(DEFERRED PROBATION)

- C. ☐ Discharged from community supervision.
- D. ☐ Discharged from community supervision. It is **FURTHER ORDERED** by the Court that the period of deferred adjudication community supervision is terminated, the charges against the Defendant are dismissed, and the Defendant is discharged from community supervision in accordance with Article 42A.701(f) of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.
