ORDER TERMINATING DEFERRED ADJUDICATION COMMUNITY SUPERVISION

Pursuant to Article 42A.111, C.C.P., it having been shown to the Court that the Defendant named herein received an Order Deferring Adjudication of a misdemeanor offense, to wit: _____ for a period of _____ **months** in the Court on the _____, and it further appearing that the Defendant named herein has successfully completed the Community Supervision term on the _____:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the accusation in said cause is ordered dismissed and the Defendant is discharged from community supervision.

It is the intent of the Court that this action shall have the effect of releasing the Defendant from all penalties and disabilities resulting therefrom except as provided by statute.

The Defendant is further informed that they ☐ **are** ☐ **are not** eligible to petition the court for an order of nondisclosure.

If eligible for an order of nondisclosure, the earliest date the Defendant will be eligible to file the petition is:

- ☐ immediately (no petition or filing fee required); or
- ☐ on the second anniversary of this order of dismissal (petition and filing fee required).

If eligible for an order of nondisclosure without filing a petition, the earliest date the Defendant will be eligible to receive an order of nondisclosure is:

- ☐ immediately (if discharge and dismissal occur on or after the 180th day after the date the Defendant was placed on deferred adjudication community supervision).
- ☐ on or after the 180th day after the date the Defendant was placed on deferred adjudication community supervision (if discharge and dismissal is less than 180 days after the date that the Defendant was placed on community supervision).

The above and foregoing shall be recorded in the Criminal Minutes in the Office of the County Clerk, for the County of Hunt, the State of Texas.
