**General Definition:**

On an assigned shift, perform various tasks of average difficulty related to a county jail, and perform related work as required.

- May be assigned a specialized task or duty
- Conduct book in procedures on inmates
- Conduct book out procedures on inmates
- Accept bonds as requested by Magistrates
- Administer medication as prescribed to inmates
- Care for general well being of inmates
- Transport prisoners to court
- Transport prisoners for medical assistance
- Enter data in the computer system as needed
- Assist in the training of less experienced jailers
- Perform all duties as may be directed by the Chief Jailer
- Perform all duties as may be directed by the Jail Administrator
- Perform all other duties as may be directed by the Sheriff
