## NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF REVISED COUNTY ELECTION PRECINCTS FOR HUNT COUNTY, TEXAS

On August 12, 2025, in open court the Commissioners of Hunt County adopted revised county election precincts to comply with Texas Election Code chapter 42. A brief description of the changes to election precincts is included as required by Texas Election Code section 42.035. The new precinct lines and numbers will become effective immediately (Section 42.033 of the Texas Election Code). New voter certificates will be mailed to each active registered voter by September 20, 2025.
