Re: 30 New Positive COVID-19 Test Results in Hunt County

30 new positive test results for COVID-19 were reported in Hunt County on November 2, 2020. The Hunt County Health Department completed an initial investigation and determined that the individuals in question reside in Hunt County. The general information for the 30 new patients is below. Hunt County will include up-to-date hospital numbers in the daily report.

The new cases are from the following areas: Greenville 75401 – 7;
Quinlan 75474 – 6;
Commerce 75428 – 6;
Greenville 75402 – 5;
Caddo Mills 71535 – 2;
West Tawakoni 75474 – 2;
Lone Oak 75453 – 1;
Wolfe City 75496 – 1.

Each day, the County will release and post on its website a new set of numbers and charts showing the total number of cases, including the status and ZIP Codes of those cases. The state’s website includes a map which may be accessed at [“dshs.state.tx.us/coronavirus”](https://dshs.state.tx.us/coronavirus) by clicking on the “Texas Case Counts” link.

The State’s COVID-19 fatality numbers exceed the locally-reported numbers of deaths. The State’s reporting can be accessed by clicking on “Fatalities over Time by County” on www.dshs.state.tx.us/coronavirus/additionaldata. As of this evening, the state shows 47 COVID-19 fatalities of Hunt County residents. This divergence is due to the way the State calculates COVID-19 deaths, which in part uses death certificate information not yet available to the County. When Hunt County releases its morning reports, it will show the number of State-reported deaths (47), the number of deaths certificates filed with the County (including non-citizen deaths) (42), and the number of County-citizen deaths that the County Health Department has been able to independently confirm (33).

It has been reported that there are a number of COVID-19 positive cases at the campuses of Texas A&M at Commerce. Information related to those case can be accessed at new.tamuc.edu/coronavirus.

New Hunt County COVID-19 Tracked Cases, as of 8:00pm November 2, 2020: “RAH” means “Recovering at Home,” “HOSP” means “Hospitalized,” “(R)” Means “Reassigned,” and “DECD” means “Deceased.”
