Re: 9 New Positive COVID-19 Test Results in Hunt County, and One

New Death

9 new positive test results for COVID-19 have been reported in Hunt County, and one new death. The Hunt County Health Department completed an initial investigation and determined that the individuals in question reside in Hunt County. The general information for the 9 new patients is on the following page. Hunt County will include up-to-date hospital numbers in the morning report.

The new cases from today are in the following general areas: Greenville 75401 - 2; Quinlan 75474 - 2; Caddo Mills 75135 - 2; Celeste 75423 - 1; Quinlan 75474 - 1; and Commerce 75428 - 1.

Each morning, the County will release and post on its website a new set of numbers and charts showing the total number of cases, including the status and ZIP Codes of those cases. The state's website includes a map which may be accessed at "dshs.state.tx.us/coronavirus" by clicking on the "Texas Case Counts" link.

The State's COVID-19 fatality numbers exceed the locally-reported numbers of deaths. The State's reporting can be accessed by clicking on "Fatalities Time County" over by www.dshs.state.tx.us/coronavirus/additionaldata. As of this evening, the state shows 30 COVID-19 fatalities of Hunt County residents. divergence is due to the way the State calculates COVID-19 deaths, which in part uses death certificate information not yet available to the County. When Hunt County releases its morning reports, it will show the number of State-reported deaths (30), the number of deaths certificates filed with the County (including non-citizen deaths) (27), and the number of Countycitizen deaths that the County Health Department has been able to independently confirm (22).

It has been reported that there are a number of COVID-19 positive cases at the campuses of Texas A&M at Commerce. Information related to those case can be accessed at new.tamuc.edu/coronavirus, which currently shows 98 students and 1 employee with positive tests, and others who are quarantined due to exposure to individuals with positive tests.
