Re: 19 New Positive COVID-19 Test Results in Hunt County

19 new positive test results for COVID-19 have been reported in Hunt County. The Hunt County Health Department completed an initial investigation and determined that the individuals in question reside in Hunt County. The general information for the 19 new patients is as follows:

In addition, Tracked Cases 199, 150 and 223 have now been hospitalized, and Tracked Cases 87, 99, 140, 167 and 180 have now been discharged from hospital.

A total of ten Hunt County residents are now hospitalized. Because three of the earlier Tracked Cases were either outside of the County or tested negative, there have been a total of 246 positive cases of Hunt County residents to date.

The 19 cases **do not include** the 25 positive results from the assisted living facility reported last night.

Each morning, the County will release and post on its website a new set of numbers and charts showing the total number of cases, including the status and ZIP Codes of those cases.
